You May Be Interested in a Different Way to Prevent CINV

If you can check any of the boxes below, ask your healthcare professional about a CINV prevention option that may be right for you



Mouth Problems

- Difficulty swallowing
- Side effects from chemotherapy, such as:
- Mouth sores
 - Breakdown of the lining of the mouth
 - Mouth infections
 - Dry mouth



Gastrointestinal (GI) Issues

- Constipation from pain medication (opioids)
- Side effects from chemotherapy, such as:
- Breakdown of the lining of the GI tract
 - Diarrhea
 - Bowel blockage
 - Abdominal pain or swelling



Chemotherapy With a 90% or More Chance of CINV

- AC (doxorubicin or epirubicin with cyclophosphamide)
- Carmustine >250 mg/m²
- Cisplatin
- Cyclophosphamide >1500 mg/m²
- Dacarbazine
- Mechlorethamine
- Streptozocin
- Carboplatin AUC >4
- Doxorubicin >60 mg/m²
- Epirubicin >90 mg/m²
- Ifosfamide >2 g/m² per dose
